



Missouri Division of Behavioral Health National Guard Initiative

The Division of Behavioral Health is collaborating with the Missouri National Guard to offer **substance abuse** consultation and evaluations, assessments, and treatment services at no cost to Missouri National Guard Soldiers.

Steps for National Guard soldiers to access services:

1. Call the DMH Veterans Services Director at 573-751-2368. **Explain that you are a "National Guard service member and you are seeking substance use assistance", this includes AGR or Air National Guard.**
2. You will be provided with contact information for the clinical office closest to your location.
3. When you show up for your appointment, present your military identification card to receive services at no cost. Consultations with National Guard soldiers should occur within two weeks of your initial contact with the treatment provider.

** If you are being referred for the evaluation by the National Guard, please present: PC Referral Sheet, DA 4465 (Patient Intake Screening), DA 4466 (Patient Progress Report) and DD 2870 (Authorization for Disclosure of Medical/Dental Information from the National Guard) and explain you will need these forms for the National Guard.*

The evaluation, consultation, and all subsequent services delivered are confidential; information about your participation will only be released to the National Guard if you sign a written release.
